Six students at D. F. Walker Junior High School are listed on the "A" honor roll for the last six weeks of the year, according to Principal Jim Kinion.

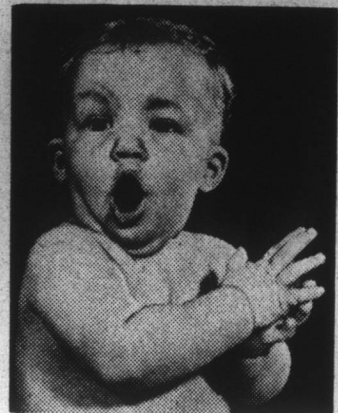

Miss Judy Earnhardt, a senior at John A. Holmes High School, is participating in a United Nations-Washington study tour this week.

The study tour is being conducted by the United Methodist Youth Fellowship of the N. C. Conference of the United Methodist Church. She is one of a group of 40 youth selected from 58 eastern counties. The study tour will attend sessions of the United Nations and the Congress of the United States. Briefings by various members of world and national governments will be features of the tour.

The purposes of the tour are (1) to understand the functions and operations of the United Nations and the United States government; (2) to provide the opportunity to participate in discussion of current world affairs; (3) to discuss the Christian's responsibility and the role of the church in the issues raised before the United Nations and the federal government, and (4) to discuss how youth can determine his Christian responsibility in these issues. The tour will include places of interest in New York City and Washington, D. C.

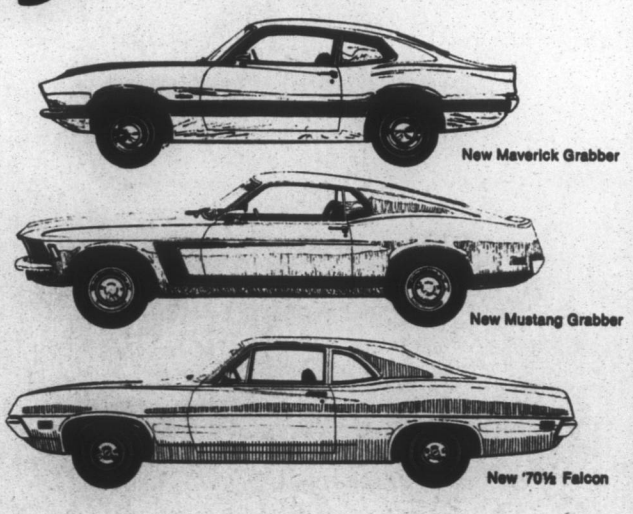
A person seeking to vote must have resided in the State of North Carolina for one year, and in the precinct in which he seeks to register for 30 days by the date of the General Election.
