



A tenant in common cannot give a lessee the exclusive possession of any part of the land which will be binding upon his cotenant, unless he has been duly authorized to act as his cotenant's agent in making the lease. If a tenant in common purports to give a lessee the exproperty, asserting that he has authority to make the lease as the agent of his cotenant, when in fact he does not, the other cotenant may, if he wishes, ratify the lease, expressly or impliedly as by rent from the lessee. Sam Smith does not have cause of action against John Jones. Either of the tenants in common, John Jones and Sam Smith, may petition the court for a sale of the house and a division of the proceeds.



No. One of several tenants in common does not have the power to modify any existing valid lease without the authority or ratification of the other cotenants.
