## Mobile Homes More Prominent

RALEIGH—Recognizing mobile homes as increasingly prominent in both rural and urban areas, Agriculture Commissioner James A. Graham has announced that he has appointed Milton Converse to serve owners and renters of the mobile units in an advisory capacity.

"This is not an additional position in the department," Graham emphasized. "In his capacity as liquefied petroleum gas inspector, Converse enters thousands of these homes annually. The work entails not only checking for safety the L. P. gas tanks and connections to the units, but also gas appliances in the homes. In the course of his work he has become familiar with many of the questions and problems of the residents and is eminently qualified to advise them which divisions of state or local governments can help them with solutions or clarify regulatory requirements."

"This is certainly not true in the N. C. Department of Agriculture," he said. "Every one of its many services are as available to mobile home occupants as to every other urban or rural citizen of the state. Such services include soil tests and inspection of nursery stock, as well as inspection and registration of fertilizers, seeds, pesticides, foods, drugs and cosmetics, gasoline and oil, weights and measures, and numerous others in addition to liquefied petroleum gases. "However, I consider the mobile home trend to be of sufficient importance as to warrant designating a member of my staff to specialize in service to mobile home occupants.

1941). The North Carolinian was born in Washington and moved at an early age to Wilson, where his widowed mother was the postmistress. He began his newspaper career at 18. He served not only for Presidents Wilson and Roosevelt but also for Grover Cleveland in the Interior Department.

The journalism professor notes in his Encyclopedia Americana article that Josephus Daniels "was widely popular (in Mexico) during the oil expropriation crisis of 1938," when he appealed to Roosevelt to forestall threatened U. S. intervention.

In 1941 Daniels went back to his editorship of the News and Observer and died in Raleigh on January 15, 1943. Before his death Josephus Daniels wrote "The Wilson Era," which was published in two volumes between 1944 and 1945.

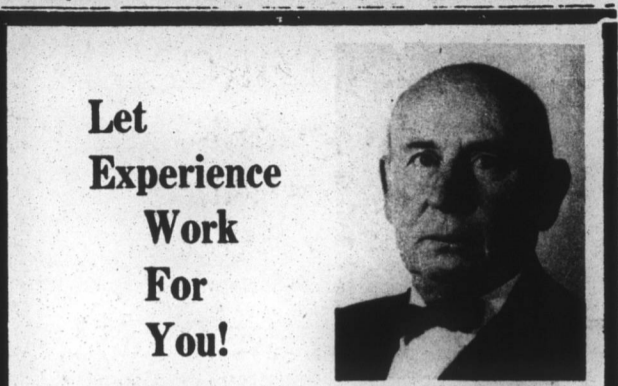
