Notice is hereby given that the Edenton Housing Authority has filed a petition in the above Court under the Public Works Eminent Domain Law to acquire by condemnation for use as a site upon which to erect low-rent dwelling units for its public housing project, the following land situated in the Town of Edenton, First Township, Chowan County, North Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

(2) The appointment of a Special Master to determine the compensation to be awarded for such property and the persons entitled thereto;

(3) The fixing of the date and place at which said Special Master shall hear and determine the compensation to be paid for such property and the person or persons entitled thereto.
