The parcle period is usually from one to five years, but the minimum, by law, in every case, is one year. The Board of Paroles has the legal right to extend the parole period beyond five years if it is thought that the parolee is in need of a longer period of supervision. At the time the parole is terminated, the parolee is granted a discharge which also terminates the sentence under which he was paroled.
