### **Social Security Questions-Answers**

Q. My 18 year old son filed for social security benefits on his deceased father's record. He is a full-time student in college. I am 43 and want to know why I cannot receive a check also. I have no other children.

A. In order for you to reto have a child under age 18 in your care or be at least 60 years old

O. My husband died last month and I have received the check for this month made payable to both of us. What should I do with the check?

A. Bring or mail the check to the social security office so that we may endorse it and you will be able to cash it for the full amount. Adjustment for the amount which is not due you will be made at a later date.

Q. How can I claim payment of doctor's bills on a deceased beneficiary?

A. If the bills have been paid, bring a paid itemized statement to your local social security office for assistance in filing a claim. If they have not been paid, your doctor can file a claim and payment can be made direct-


