
## Commission Okays Proposed 17 Bypass

This approved corridor is the same as recommended by the state at the public hearing here on February 23.

The proposed by-pass begins at the east end of Chowan River bridge, follows existing U. S. 17 for a short distance and then is on new location north of Edenton. I crosses Highway 32 north of the new Chowan Hospital and ties back into U.S. 17 approximately 8,000 feet west of the Chowan-Perquimans coun-




