Here is a recipe which is very delicious. It's a Pennsylvania Dutch recipe:

Shoo-Fly Pie
1 T. flour.
1 unbaked 10-inch pie shell.
2/3 cup molasses (half should be light molasses).
2/3 cup boiling water.
2/3 tsp. baking soda.
1/3 cup shortening.
1 1/2 cups flour.
1/2 cup packed brown sugar.
1/4 tsp. salt.
Sprinkle the 1 T. flour on bottom of pie shell. Mix molasses with boiling water and soda; pour into pie shell. Cut shortening into the 1 1/2 cups flour, sugar and salt; sprinkle mixture over filling. Bake in 350 degree oven 45 to 50 minutes or until filling is slightly firm. Serve warm or cold.

Another timely recipe is for wilted lettuce:
2 slices bacon.
1/4 cup vinegar.
2 tbs sugar.
1/2 tsp. salt.
1/2 tsp. dry mustard.
1 small head lettuce or leaf lettuce.

A Few Hints
Try rubbing on insect stinging a slice of lemon for instant relief.
Put a little scouring powder on your stainless steel pans, then rub with paper towel to clean.
