

Minutes Of Board Of County Commissioners For Month June

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session Monday, June 1, 1970, at 9 o'clock A. M., with all members present: J. Clarence Leary, chairman, C. M. Evans, C. A. Phillips, David T. Bateman and N. J. George.

The minutes of the previous meetings were read and approved.

On motion of C. A. Phillips, seconded by C. M. Evans and unanimously carried that the resignation of Ernest P. Kehayes from Mental Health and Rehabilitation Service be accepted with regret. The clerk was instructed to write Mr. Kehayes a letter of appreciation for his services in this capacity.

The meeting was recessed to meet jointly with the North Carolina Department of

Local Affairs that a Federal Urban Planning Assistance Grant had been approved for the County of Chowan, and a proposed contract, designated County Contract No. NCP-131-14, between the County and the North Carolina Department of Local Affairs for the provision of planning services was presented and discussed; that, under the terms of the said contract, the County will pay a total of \$1,560.00 as its share of the planning costs, the same being due in two payments, the first payment of \$780.00 to be

due thirty (30) days after execution of the contract, and the balance of \$780.00 to be due February 1, 1971.

Commissioner David T. Bateman introduced the following resolution, which was read:

1. That the contract between the County of Chowan and the North Carolina Department of Local Affairs be and the same is hereby approved.

2. That the Chairman and the County Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to sign and execute the said contract for and on behalf of the County of Chowan and forward the same to the North Carolina Department of Local Affairs.

3. That upon final execution a copy of the said contract be filed with the minutes.

Upon motion of Commissioner David T. Bateman, seconded by Commissioner C. A. Phillips, said resolution was unanimously passed.

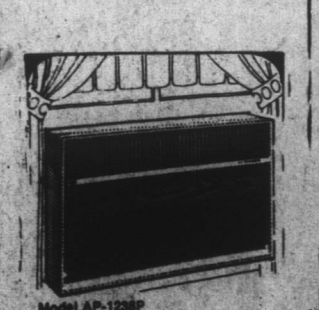
