 him up as a human sacrifice. Here we must remember that in Biblical times human sacrifices was a common thing. Fathers often offered their sons on the altars of the

pagan gods in whom they believed. And if pagans could do this, how much less could Abraham, who professed the one true God? What a painful journey this must have been for this old man. Yet from the beginning did he not testify to his faith? "I and the lad will go yonder and worship, and come again to you" he said to the two companions he was to leave behind as the designated place hove into view. And, in answer to his son's question as to how he would make a sacrifice without the body of a lamb—"The Lord will provide." And the Lord did. As always before, His mercy was manifested. As it always will be. All that is necessary is obedient and persistent faith—and the Lord always provides.
