



Duke Looks To Chesson For Big Football Plays

DURHAM—Although Duke has the ability and desire to make the big play in the Atlantic Coast Conference returning for the 1970 season in Wes Chesson, the Blue Devils' receiving corps lacks the depth they have enjoyed in the past.

The Blue Devils lost tight end Jim Dearth and flanker Marcel Courtillet via graduation and return only two lettermen in the vital receiving area.

Chesson, a 6-2, 190-pounder from Edenton, already holds the career yards receiving record for the Blue Devils with 1,319 yards. In two seasons, the speedy receiver has caught 90 passes for five touchdowns. He needs just eight passes to become the leading receiver in Duke history.

"I feel Wes Chesson is one of the finest athletes to ever play at Duke," commented head coach Tom Harp. "He last season," added Harp.

"Our newcomers will have to develop quickly. We have talent but they lack that all important game experience." the following week against Duke opens the 1970 season.

Food Stamp Business Is Brisk Here

Chowan County Department of Social Services reports participation in the food stamp program continued brisk in July, a month in which those certified usually drops. There were 152 families certified during the month.

Robert Hendrix, director, reported to county commissioners last Monday that 144 participated, paying \$4,717.50 and receiving stamps valued at \$14,656.

Hendrix said during the month the department had 518 cases in which financial assistance and/or service was rendered.

Other aspects of the department activities included:

Aid to Aged: 93 cases, \$4,820 grant, \$51.82 average.

Aid to Dependent Children: 71 cases, \$6,443 grant, \$21.99 average.

Aid to Disabled: 42 cases,

\$2,285 grant, \$54.40 average.

Aid to Blind: 13 cases, \$708 grant, \$54.56 average.

General assistance, \$60.41; 12 hospitalized in the county at a cost of \$3,011.44 from joint funds; four hospitalized outside the county, \$3,914.99, joint funds; 16 out-patients, \$269.84, joint funds and 146 pharmacy bills, \$1,799.35, joint funds.

Five dental services, \$240, joint funds; 117 physician services, \$3,672.52, county funds; eight nursing home cases, \$2,564.13, joint funds; four home-health services, \$181.25, joint funds and 10 optical services, \$258.65, joint funds.

There were 97 social security by-ins, \$205.70, joint funds.
