#### GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT ADULT EDUCATION COURSES

These programs are offered for self-interest and self-improvement. They are open to any person 18 years of age or over who is not enrolled in a high school. There is no maximum age limit. Persons 16 to 18 years old with "special needs" may enroll with permission of the local school superintendent. Classes are free to "Senior Citizens" 65 years of age and older. For most classes, there is a \$2.00 fee payable the first night of the course.
