### Fire Standards Depend on Risk

New standards for fabric flammability must be technologically practicable and involve a realistic "trade-off" between costs and risk, according to Geoffrey V. Lund, director of research and development for M. Lowenstein & Sons, Inc.

"This means," said Mr. Lund, "that the development of technology must precede the enactment of new standards. Right now we are at the point where we have developed the method to treat children's sleepwear and some bedding components."

"It would be impossible to have a uniform standard for fabric flammability," Mr. Lund added. "It is more likely that different standards will have to be developed for each and use depending on the type and nature of the hazard involved."
