I would like to set up a new system so that the players can handicap their play easier and make matches more even. It's called the "Dog-Fight" System. You can play this system with one player against another or twosomes against twosomes or foursomes vs. foursomes, or you can even have tournaments using it.

It will help to promote golf and to encourage fair play and to educate all players to the adherence of the rules of golf.

It's a lot of fun, so let's give it a try.

The winners will be determined by the highest number of points above his quota or the lowest minus.

For example: If a player has to pull 20 points and he pulls 22, he will be plus 2. If he pulls only 15, he will be minus 5.

All the individual handicap cards have been posted in red with the quota for that player, so check your handicap cards for your quotas.

Any questions on the system on how to conduct teams or foursomes, please contact me and I will explain.

All players will be given a quota in accordance with his handicap. The maximum number of points shall be 38 points for a 0 handicapper and a minimum of 6 points for a 32 or over handicapper.

A player scores points as follows:

- Each bogey .....1 point
  - Each par .....2 points
  - Each birdie .....4 points
  - Each eagle .....8 points
  - Each ace .....8 points
  - Each double eagle 16 points
- Each player will be given a quota of points based on the following comparison table:
