Hicks Named To State Post

Jesse L. Hicks has been appointed state conservationist of the USDA-Soil Conservation Service for North Carolina effective June 14.

He will be the fifth person to hold the post in more than 35 years of SCS conservation work through soil and water conservation districts in North Carolina.

Longest-term State Conservationist was E. B. Garrett, now retired, who held it from the mid-30's until August 31, 1959. He was succeeded by Richard M. Dailey, who served from September 1, 1959, to the same day in 1963. Joseph P. Kuykendall was State Conservationist from 1963 to January 1, 1968, and was succeeded by Charles W. Bartlett, who was transferred from North Carolina to Georgia on June 1, 1971.

Hicks will move to his Raleigh assignment from Columbus, Ohio, where he is deputy state conservationist.
