

Hollowell Works For Galifianakis

Rep. Nick Galifianakis has named Hertford businessman Joel Hollowell, Jr., as manager of his U. S. Senate campaign in Perquimans County. Hollowell, former mayor of Winfall, is chairman of the Perquimans County Industrial Development Committee and a member of the N. C. Petroleum Association, the N. C. Oil Jobbers Association and the National Fuel Oil Institute. He is a member of the Ruritan Club and a past district governor of Ruritan National. He will be coordinating his efforts in behalf of Galifianakis with state campaign manager Russell Walker of Ashboro.

After the announcement, Hollowell said he had decided to work for Galifianakis, a candidate for U. S. Senate in the May 6 Democratic primary, because "Nick is a solid, reliable legislator who is always responsible to the needs of the people. I am confident that he will give Eastern North Carolina the long-overdue representation it needs to produce real economic progress."

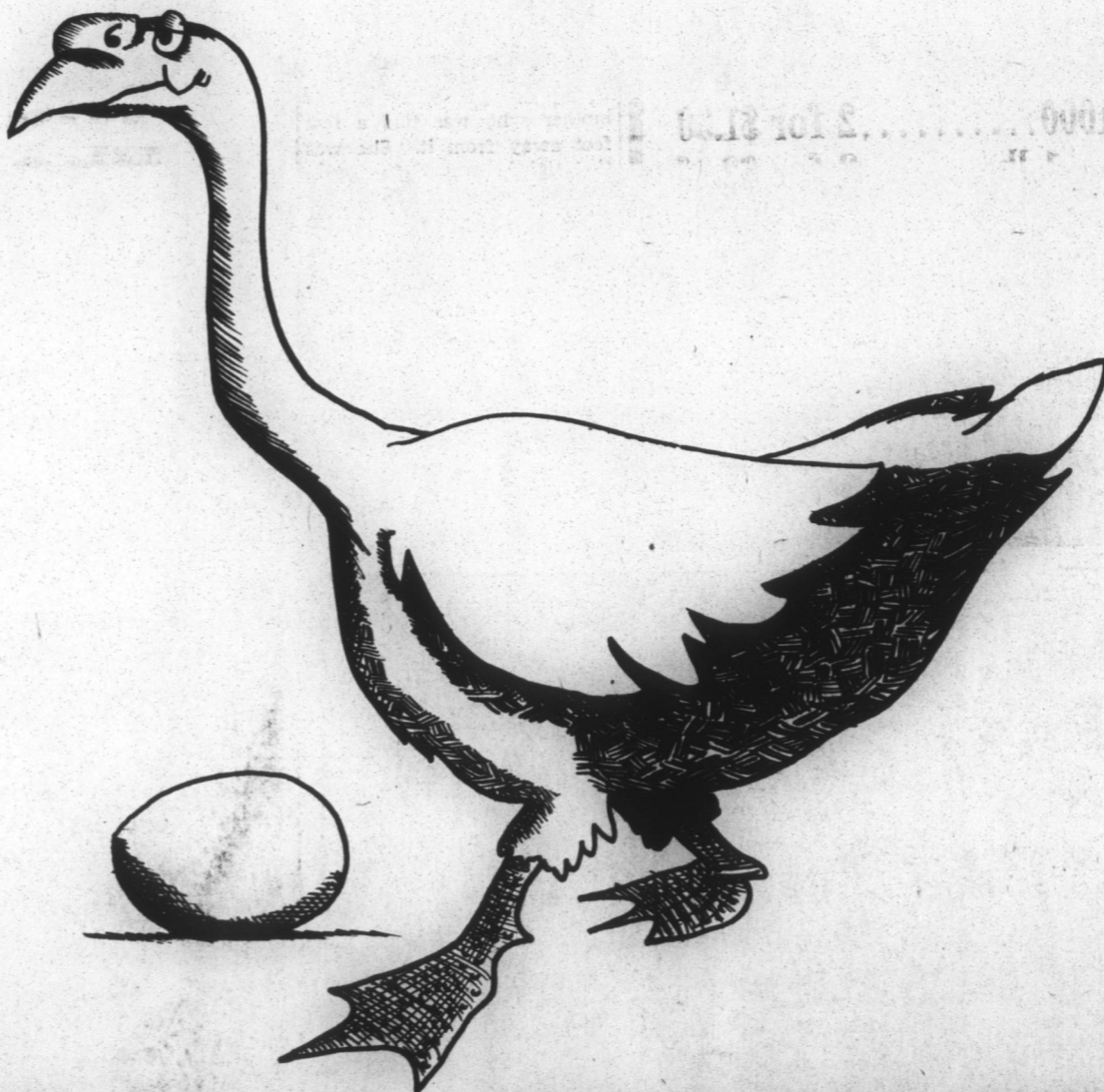
Are you aware that certain capital improvements and services requested by the principals and School Board after months of study were cut from the current budget?
