Edenton Is Recognized For Pedestrian Safety

Edenton, competing with 1,146 cities in the United States, has been given special recognition for its outstanding efforts to prevent pedestrian accidents in 1971 by the Carolina Motor Club and the American Automobile Association.

The basis for the award was Edenton's report submitted to the AAA's 33rd Annual Pedestrian Safety Inventory.

In accepting the award on behalf of the city, Chief J. D. Parrish gave full credit to the citizens, both pedestrians and drivers, as well as to the Edenton Police Department and civic organizations.

However, he added, there is no room for complacency, because the downward trend in pedestrian deaths throughout the nation, evident since the beginning of the AAA program, reversed itself in 1962 and is still on the increase.

He declined to be pessimistic about the increase in national pedestrian fatalities last year, 10,400 over 9,800 the previous year. When AAA began its Pedestrian Safety Program in 1937, when only 107 cities participated, there were 15,500 pedestrian traffic fatalities. Since that time, the nation's cities have managed to reduce the death toll by approximately 37 per cent.
