They will have displays of machinery and demonstrations, peanut varieties and other items that should be of interest to peanut farmers. All people connected with peanuts are invited to attend. We would like to see our peanut farmers in Chowan County take part in this event as we believe it will be of benefit, not only to hear what is said on the program but to talk to peanut farmers from other counties.
