

To prelect your corn from weevils for the coming year we suggest that if you store your corn, you clean out your bins, spray with premium grade malathion and when you are putting the corn into the bin to store, apply malathion onto the grain as it is going into the auger. This will project your grain from weevils in the spring of the year and is both cheap and safe to usc. If you have questions, on the amount or the kind to use on stored grain, contact either the Extension office or your distributor.


