### Guilty Of Intimidation, Woman Gets Active Term

An Edenton woman was convicted of intimidating and interfering with a witness by Judge Wilton F. Walker, Jr., last week in Chowan County District Court. Fanny Granby received an active sentence of six months and did not appeal the decision.

Previously, probable cause had been found in the case of Cleveland Boston accused of assault with intent to rape a 12 year old girl. In the hearing, Judge Walker had warned that intimidating would be dealt with by the court.

Ralph Fay Nixon was found guilty of four charges resulting from an extensive chase from Chowan County into Perquimans County involving the Chowan County Sheriff's Department and Perquimans authorities. He was found guilty of speeding in excess of 90 miles per hour, reckless driving, driving drunk, second offense, and possession of a weapon of mass destruction.

The first two charges were consolidated for judgment. He received six months, suspended, \$150 fine and costs, and not to operate a motor vehicle until license returned. For driving drunk, he received six months, suspended upon payment of a fine of \$250 and costs.

In addition, Nixon was sentenced to 30 days, suspended, \$25 fine and costs and the

sawed off shotgun was confiscated.

Nixon appealed all of the sentences and appearance bond was set at \$1,500.

Other cases prosecuted included:

Leonard Collins, improper registration, \$35 fine and costs.

Clyde Rogers Jordan, speeding 90 miles in a 55 mph zone, 60 days, suspended, \$100 fine and costs, and not to operate a motor vehicle in North Carolina until license returned.

Walter Augustus Goodman, improper passing, 10 days, suspended upon payment of cost of court.

Grady Fenner, driving drunk, 90 days, suspended, \$125 fine and costs. Defendant appealed and bond was set at \$500.

Edward White, allowing an unlicensed person to operate a motor vehicle, 30 days, suspended, \$125 fine and costs.

Michael James Freeman, Jr., reckless driving, 60 days, suspended, \$100 fine and costs.

Walter Lee Miller, allowing an unlicensed person to operate a motor vehicle, 30 days, suspended, \$25 fine and costs.

Robert Privott, driving drunk, 90 days, suspended, \$150 fine and costs, and not to operate a motor vehicle in North Carolina for 12 months.
