

Colonial Funeral Home Staff Expanded

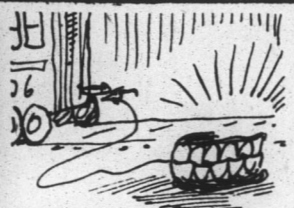

missioners that the bid from Simpson Equipment Corporation on truck front loader and packer at price of \$30,186.47 plus tax and 60 containers price \$15,109 plus tax represents the equipment that will best serve the landfill project. It was noted that Perquimans County Board will meet at a later date to take action on the equipment for the landfill project and that actual purchase of equipment would have to await the decision of the Perquimans County Board and the review of all legal aspects concerning the equipment by the joint committee and the attorneys of Chowan and Perquimans County. Motion was made by David T. Bateman,

seconded by C. M. Evans that the committee be authorized at their discretion to proceed with purchase of the equipment recommended after all legal considerations have been satisfied. Members voting yes: J. Clarence Leary, C. M. Evans, David T. Bateman; no, N. J. George.

C. M. Evans, member of the landfill committee, reported on equipment to be used at the landfill site. It is the feeling of the committee that bid submitted by Gregory Poole Company for caterpillar 955-L at price of \$34,959 is the equipment best suited for this purpose. Motion made by J. Clarence Leary, seconded by David T. Bateman that the landfill committee be authorized to proceed

with purchase of equipment needed after Perquimans County Commissioners had met and made recommendations and after all matters had been received by the landfill committee, and the attorneys from the two counties and the participating FHA and health agencies. Members voting yes: J. Clarence Leary, C. M. Evans, David T. Bateman; voting no, N. J. George.

Upon motion of N. J. George, seconded by J. Clarence Leary and unanimously carried approving FHA Form 400-1 equal opportunity agreement Rev. 2-17-71.

Upon motion of N. J. George, seconded by C. M. Evans and unanimously carried agreeing to exercise the

authorities granted in General Statutes 153-272 through 275. These statutes deal with the collection and disposal of refuse.

Melvin Howell, FHA county supervisor, gave a report on the county water system. The following reports were accepted and ordered filed: Edenton - Chowan Rescue Squad; Treasurer; Veterans Service Officer; County Accountant; Coroner; Tax Collector; Agricultural Extension Department; Social Services Department.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
