Veterans' Week Being Observed

The nation and Edenton celebrated Veterans' Day Monday (formerly Armistice Day) and Gov. Bob Scott proclaimed this week, October 23-29, as Veterans' Week in North Carolina.

Said the governor: "The American soldier is every man and woman who has worn the military uniform of the United States with honor and he needs no eulogy from any man, but it is most fitting that we pause in the national life he has helped make possible to say with gratitude, thank you for this precious gift of freedom."

In Edenton, Bob Jenkins, manager of the Employment Security Commission office, reports the theme of this year's Veterans Week observance is "Remembering POW-MIAs and Veterans." The POW-MIAs are the prisoners of war and those missing in action in Southeast Asia.

He said that more than 76,000 Vietnam veterans have returned to North Carolina, and that many state agencies are joining forces to help these returning men and women find civilian employment.

"Employment of veterans is one of the three points state government wishes to emphasize during Veterans Week," said Jenkins. "Veterans unemployment, particularly joblessness among Vietnam era veterans, has been abnormally high in recent years. Our primary interest during Veterans Week is to emphasize the need veterans have for jobs, but we would also like the public to be aware of the sacrifices being made by people in the armed forces."

Unemployment among veterans has averaged between 8 and 9 per cent in recent years, according to the employment office manager, or nearly twice the national adult average. Although precise figures are not available for North Carolina, veterans employment officials believe veterans' unemployment here is below the national average.

International Post To Larsh

Dr. John E. Larsh, associate dean of the UNC School of Public Health, has been elected president of the International Commission on Trichinellosis.

His election was made public following a world-wide balloting among the commission's members in 23 countries.

Dr. Larsh is professor and chairman of the UNC School of Public Health's Department of Parasitology and Laboratory Practice.

He is the father-in-law of Frank Williams, Jr., and is a frequent visitor of Chowan County, where he has a cottage at Nixon's Beach.

The UNC professor will be executive director of the Third International Conference on Trichinellosis to be held in Miami Beach, Fla., in November. The first two conferences were held in Poland.

Dr. Larsh explains that trichinellosis (trichinosis) is an important medical and public health problem throughout most of the world. The disease is caused by eating improperly cooked meat, especially pork, which contains the parasitic worm trichinella.
