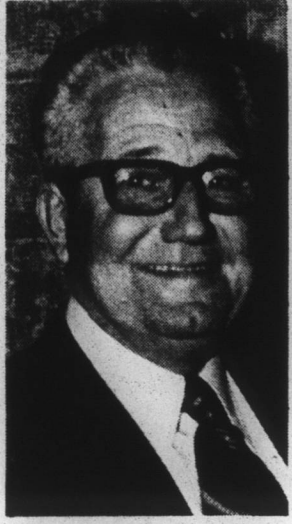


Fiberform Chief Named To Board
