Know Your Social Security

Field Representative Most area farmers are familiar, with the farmer's option on figuring their self employment income for social security purposes. Briefly it permits a farmer who does not clear \$400 from his farming operation to report 2-3rds of his gross income up to a maximum of \$1600.

This method of computing self-employment income was limited to farmers only. The social security amendments have changed this and it will be available to all self employed people for taxable years beginning after 1972.

For non-farm self employed people there are some restrictions in using the option. First, you must have had at least \$400 net income from self employment in two of the three years immediately preceeding the use of the option. Second, it can only be used five times. 




