
TEAMWORK FOR A COMMON GOAL

Aims Program

RALEIGH - Adults who have less than a high school education will have a chance to obtain one through a program co-sponsored by the University of North Carolina television network and the technicalinstitute community college

The television program, called "Your Future Is Now," will begin October 2 and run until May 9 on ETV. The series will help prepare adults to pass the General Educational Development tests. When a person successfully completes the tests, he receives a high school certificate issued by the State Board of Education.

Guide books which accompany the course may be obtained at technical institutes and community colleges.

The lessons will include social studies, science, literature, mathematics and English.

Each lesson will be broadcast twice on Tuesdays and Thursday at 2 P.M. and 7 P.M. On Sundays the lessons will be repeated at 3 and 3:30 P.M.

The following area television station will broadcast the series: WUND (Channel 2) Columbia.

To Solve Wheat **Transportation**

Improvisation becomes essential when the right kind of railroad rolling stock is not available to do the job. This happened when United States wheat went international and the bulk of the Russian grain movement to shipping ports had to be handled along with the regular domestic harvest.

Highly sophisticated computer systems were utilized by some individual railroads. An unprecedented conversion of coal open hopper cars, cleaned and outfitted with covers to haul grain was initiated.

The Illinois Central Gulf Railroad experimented with a removable fiberglass top to convert open hopper cars into covered cars for grain handling. The test was made with turn-around trains between Iowa points and the Chicago ports. It was an unqualified success, according to railroad officials.

Allan S. Boyd, president of the railroad said that, "Its success gives an exciting glimpse of possibilities for economical equipping to handle the larger volumes of export grain that seems to be in our future."
