Describing the long Form 1040 and the short Form 1040A, which are now being printed, DeWitt estimated that over 1.8million individual returns would be filed in North Carolina for 1973.

Steps taken by the IRS to improve tax forms, DeWitt said ould enable many taxpayers to complete their returns with less difficulty and in less time than last year.

So that taxpayers can file early and receive refunds in less time than those filing closer to the April 15 due date, DeWitt urged employers to distribute W-2 withholding forms as soon as possible. W-2's for 1973, *generally, must be distributed

by January 31, 1974. Most taxpayers who file in January receive their refunds in four to five weeks, while later filers may have to wait as long as eight weeks, because of the greater volume of returns

received, DeWitt said. The major improvements in the 1973 tax forms are:
