**PLANT TREES**

Many areas of cut-over land and poor cropland could be put back into productivity by planting them in pine trees. Some of the species suited for planting in North Carolina are loblolly, slash and longleaf. The longleaf is best suited for growth on dry Sandhill sites. The loblolly and slash can be planted on "average" upland sites out of the Sandhills.

The Division of Health Services has received an application from the County of Chowan for a State grant under the North Carolina Clean Water Bond Act of 1971. The application seeks a grant of \$105,000.00 from funds allocated for use in Chowan County and \$625,500.00 from funds allocated for Statewide use. This grant would be applied as a portion of the construction cost of a water supply system project. The project consists of construction of 4 deep wells, 2 water treatment plants, 3 elevated water storage tanks and a distribution system of 10, 8, 6 and 4 inch water mains with fire hydrants and meters.
