This quote from George Leonard which appeared in a June, 1958, "Look" magazine article is just as appropriate today. Answers to both these questions plus deliberations about quantity, quality and kind of education in Chowan County have led your school board to project a plan for the reorganization of the school system through the elimination of Swain and White Oak Schools, and the building of a new school. Needless to say, it has evoked controversy!


