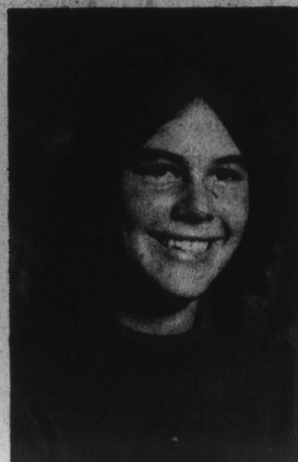


Legion Auxillary Selects Three Delegates To Attend Girls' State
