

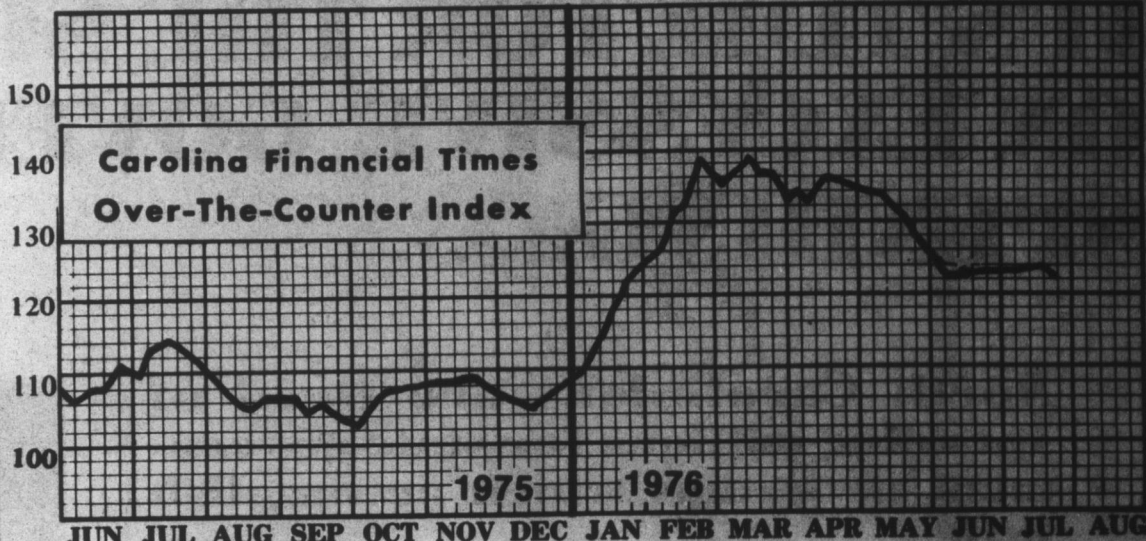

INDEX FALLS TO 122.2

After two weeks of holding steady at 124.0, the Carolina Financial Times over-the-counter index fell to 122.2 last week. Trading remained slow, as it has been all summer, according to brokers.

Stocks which moved up included Rose's Stores, up 5; and Atlantic Pepsi, Bi-Lo Inc., Lowe's Companies, Multimedia Inc., Savannah Foods and Service Merchandise, all up fractions.

Stocks which fell included Wright Machinery, down 1-7/8; Rich's Inc., down 1; and Bassett Furniture, Daniel International, Lance Inc., Sonoco Products, Wix Corp., First Union Corp., Northwestern Financial Corp. and Home Beneficial class B, all down fractions.
