Hodges To Offer Radio-TV Repair Classes At COA

College of The Albemarle, is making preparations to begin a new class in Radio and TV Repair at the Technical Center.

The first quarter of the four-quarter series began on Monday and continues through December 15. Classes will meet each Monday and Wednesday evening in Room 150 from 7 until 10 o'clock.

Hodges said the first 60-hour segment will deal with basic electricity and electronics. After that, the instruction progresses in interest. Students will be taught the theory and servicing of radio receivers during the second quarter. The third and fourth quarters involve the repair of television receivers.

Those who choose to enroll

in the full series will spend a total of 240 hours in class and practical work. The instructor emphasized the fact that no prior experience in electronics is necessary to enroll in his course. He said a great deal of personal enjoyment and saving can be derived from the knowledge acquired in the class.

The adult interest course is sponsored by COA's Continuing Education Department. A registration fee of \$5 will be charged for each quarter, and registrants are required to have their Social Security numbers with them to enroll.
