Trailsway Bus Station.

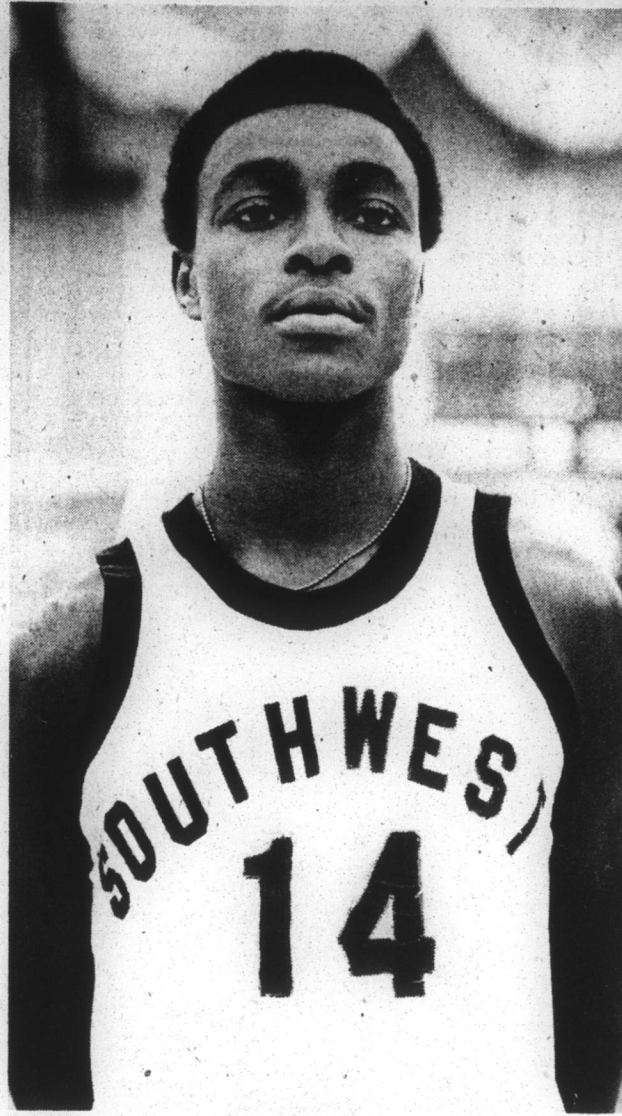

Bond comes to the Mustangs from the College of the Albemarle in Elizabeth City, N. C.

Willie is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Charlie Bond of Edenton. He is majoring in health and physical education at Southwest State.

Bond was an all-conference selection at J. A. Holmes High School where he was coached by Tom Bass. He also was a two letterman at College of the Albemarle.

SSU coach Dale Honeck commented, "Willie is a transfer student with quickness and shooting ability. He could be a big factor for us this year."

Bond is currently leading the Mustangs in free-throw shooting. After 11 games, he is shooting 88 per cent from the line.

Southwest State University is one of the nation's newest and most modern universities. The school opened its doors in 1967 on a 216-acre campus with a physical plant of over 23 buildings.

Last year the Mustang basketball team finished 14-13, advancing to the NAIA District playoffs, and captured second place in the Northern Intercollegiate Conference with an 8-4 record.
