The Aces were well represented last weekend at the State Wrestling Tournament in Winston-Salem. John A. Holmes High School definitely was one of the small schools in the field of over 100 schools. Yet the Aces placed a three way tie for 10th place in the state.

He was 4-0 at the state tournament, with a pin in the first round (1:07, second), and three decision wins, (11-3), (7-2), and the 7-5 championship win Saturday

In addition to Brown the wrestlers at the tournament. Kenneth Bond was defeated twice in the 148
