Tax Refunds Now Total \$129-Million

GREENSBORO — With eight weeks of the 15-week filing period gone by, North Carolinians are mailing in their Federal income tax returns at almost the same regularity as in past years, the Internal Revenue Service says.

As of February 25, 803,540 Tax Heels had filed their returns. Not all these have been processed, but 351,331 refunds have been issued for a total of \$129-million, an average of \$367 per refund.

The number of returns filed indicate only a 3 per cent decrease this year over the same period last year. With seven weeks to go before the midnight, April 15 deadline, taxpayers are tackling the forms in hopes of being one of the \$1.6-million expected to receive a refund.

Quite a few are making errors that can delay that refund. Mostly, the errors are in arithmetic - addition, subtraction, wrong calculation of General Tax Credit or Earned Income Credit. Also, the additional calculations required on the short Form 1040A are causing some headshaking at return preparation time.

Taxpayers having a problem, or a question regarding any portion of the tax return should first reread their tax instructions, or call the IRS toll-free number 1-800-822-8800. The lines are open every weekday from 8 A. M. to 5 P. M.
