

### Varied Court Docket

John Richard Turner, 43, Route 1, Tyner, was given an active 12-month sentence in Chowan County District Court Tuesday on counts of drunk driving, fourth offense, and driving while his license was revoked. Two lesser charges were dismissed.

Judge Grafton G. Beaman entered the sentence and recommended Turner for work release.

Asst. Dist. Atty. David Blackwell prosecuted the docket and Arthur B. Harrison, 28-year-old Negro, 302 Stokes Drive, Hertford, was given a suspended sentence for making false statements to the N.C. Employment Security Commission. Harrison was charged in seven cases.

He was sentenced to 150 days, suspended upon payment of \$180 fine and costs and make restitution in the amount of \$541.
