
More Peanut Festival Scenes

Peoples Bank Earnings Up

ROCKY MOUNT-Peoples Bank and Trust Company has reported that earnings for the period ending September 30, 1977, were \$2,003,000 compared to \$1,893,000 earned during the same period last year, an increase of 5.8 per cent. On a per share basis, this amounted to \$2.52 compared to \$2.39 per share reported in 1976.


Income before security transactions was \$1,978,000 or \$2.49 per share compared to \$1,854,000 or \$2.34 per share, an increase of 6.7 per cent.

Total assets increased to \$284.3-million compared to \$264.8-million in 1976, an increase of 7.4 per cent. Gross loans for the period rose to \$158.1-million compared to \$155.5-million reported last year, an increase of 19 per cent. Total deposits for the period rose to \$256.6-million, a 7.8 per cent increase above the \$238-million reported during the same period last year.


