Unemployment Rate Shows Slight Decline

RALEIGH — The nation's average rate of insured unemployment fell below the critical 4.5 per cent level for the 13 weeks ending January 3, signalling the end of extended unemployment payments in North Carolina and much of the rest of the nation, according to the Employment Security Commission (ESC).

Warren Wittmer, director of ESC's Unemployment Insurance Division, said extended jobless benefits would be payable through the week ending January 24. Extended benefits have been payable since the week ending July 26.

During the 13 weeks ending January 3, the nation's average rate of insured unemployment registered 4.49 per cent.

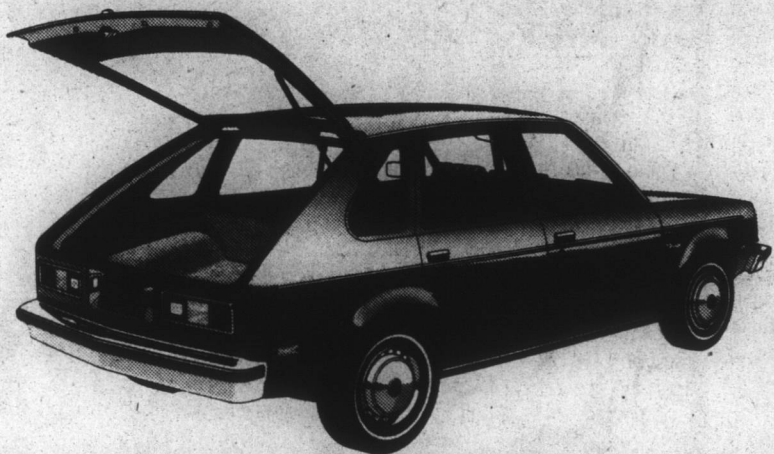

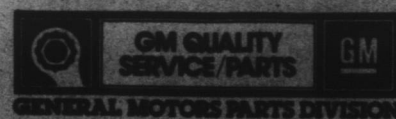
