New Dental Facility

The building has been planned for the comfortable use of not only the general dentistry practice of the owners, but also for the needs of the satellite practices of dental specialists who have scheduled office hours several days a month in the present Hornthal and Sick

Dr. Kenneth Manning, an orthodontist from Washington, N. C., and Dr. Jasper Lewis, a childrens dental specialist from Greenville, N. C., will continue as they have in the past to time - share in the New Mark Drive location. Plans are under way for an additional specialist's satellite practice in the office in the near future.


