**Highlights**

Three units of the Plymouth Wood Products Group hit new productivity achievements in January.

The Plymouth Lumber Planer Mill established a new monthly production record by finishing an average of more than 28,000 board feet of lumber per hour.

The Plymouth Wood Treating Plant set a new weekly production mark the last week in January by treating 66 charges of lumber and Landscape Timbers. The Treating Plant "A" Shift processed a record 34 charges, and "B" Shift treated 32 charges.
