## Little Hope in Redistricting Order

**REDISTRICTING**-The North Carolina General Assembly's 1982 redistricting took another step backward last week, U.S. Chief Justice Warren Burger refused to grant a stay of a previous court to redraw several legislative districts that, according to a federal threejudge panel, violates the voting rights of blacks.

The decision by Burger was not altogether unexpected and legislative leaders said late Friday that the motion for a stay would now be taken before the full U.S. Supreme Court.
