**NASA Research Fellowship Award**

ELIZABETH CITY, N.C.—Dr. Ellis Eugene Lawrence, Associated Professor and Coordinator of the Industrial Technology Program at Elizabeth City State University, has been awarded a 10-week summer research fellowship by the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA). He has been assigned as Chief Scientist in the Facility Engineering Area. Langley Research Center, Va.

Since 1964, NASA has supported a program of summer faculty fellowships for engineering and science educators to further the professional knowledge of qualified engineering and science faculty members, stimulate an exchange of ideas, while enriching the research and teaching activities of the participant's institution and contributing to the research objectives of the NASA Center.

Lawrence, a member of the EC-SU faculty since 1980, earned the Ed. D. degree in Vocational Technical Education with cognate in Industrial Engineering from Virginia Polytechnic Institute, Blacksburg, Va., and M.S. in Industrial Arts Education and a B.S. in Vocational-Industrial Education, both from N.C. Agricultural and Technical State University, Greensboro, N.C.

Under his leadership as initiator and major investigator for national accreditation of the ECSU Industrial Technology Program, accreditation was received in October 1983. He has served as a consultant at the National Center of Research in Vocational Education at Ohio State University and for the Greensboro, N.C., City Schools in the planning of the Vocational Skill Center.

Lawrence also is an active member of The American Institute of Industrial Engineers, the Society of Automotive Engineers, the National Association of Industrial Technology, Epsilon Pi Tau, Honorary Professional Fraternity for Education in Technology and Phi Delta Kappa.

He resides in Hertford, N.C., is married and has one child.

**Spotted Fever Fatal Illness**

Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever—every year we hear about it as warm weather brings out the ticks that carry it, and the humans and animals that ticks like to bite. In 1984, 178 people in North Carolina contracted the disease; five died from it.

Doctors say that the disease is easy to treat using well-known antibiotics, provided it is diagnosed early. The North Carolina Memorial Hospital has a brochure and a telephone information tape to help families learn more about this potentially fatal illness.

The most common symptoms of the disease are fever, headache or muscle aches and a skin rash. Doctors caution, however, that anyone who suspects they may have the disease should go immediately to a local emergency room, even if they have no rash.
