The North Carolina Division of Environmental Management of the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development has received an application from the Arrowhead Property Owners Association of Tyrner, N.C., in Chowan County, for a Water Quality Certification pursuant to Section 401 of the Federal Clean Water Act as amended. The activity for which the Certification is sought is the creation of artificial fishing reefs in Chowan River adjacent to Arrowhead Beach Subdivision. The purpose of the artificial reefs would be to improve recreation fishing in the area. The reefs would be created with concrete rubble and steel from a demolished bridge.

The public is invited to comment on the impact of the proposed project on water quality. A copy of the application may be inspected at the Department's office in Raleigh, Archdale Building, 512 N. Salisbury
