A listing, compiled off Herpingsham County, Ray Winton was educated in that county's schools and UNC-Chapel Hill. His work as a professional genealogist has led him into many related endeavors.

He was responsible for the historical text of the "Architectural Survey of Herpingsham County" and was a major contributor to "North Carolina Research: Genealogy and Local History", which is a standard publication recognizing the availability and usage of North Carolina records.

Currently, he is editor of the North Carolina Genealogical Society Journal, which is published quarterly. He is also President of the Herpingsham County Historical Society, Archivist of the Herpingsham County Historical Association, a director of the North Carolina Genealogy and History Society, and a writer of a weekly newspaper column on local history. In addition, he is working on a book which will be entitled "Genealogy in Herpingsham County".
