### **Book Out**

The Internal Revenue Service announced a new publication designed to help Individual Retirement Account owners and beneficiaries determine their required distributions.

Publication 903, 1987 Required Distributions from Individual Retirement Arrangements (IRAs) explains in plain language the distributions that must be made to certain IRA owners who reached age 701/2 in 1986 or in earlier years, and the distribution most important when requirements for beneficiaries of IRA owners who died before 1987.

Competition between youngsters is also held on a local state and international level. The four goals of the program are education, enjoyment, safety and competition.


