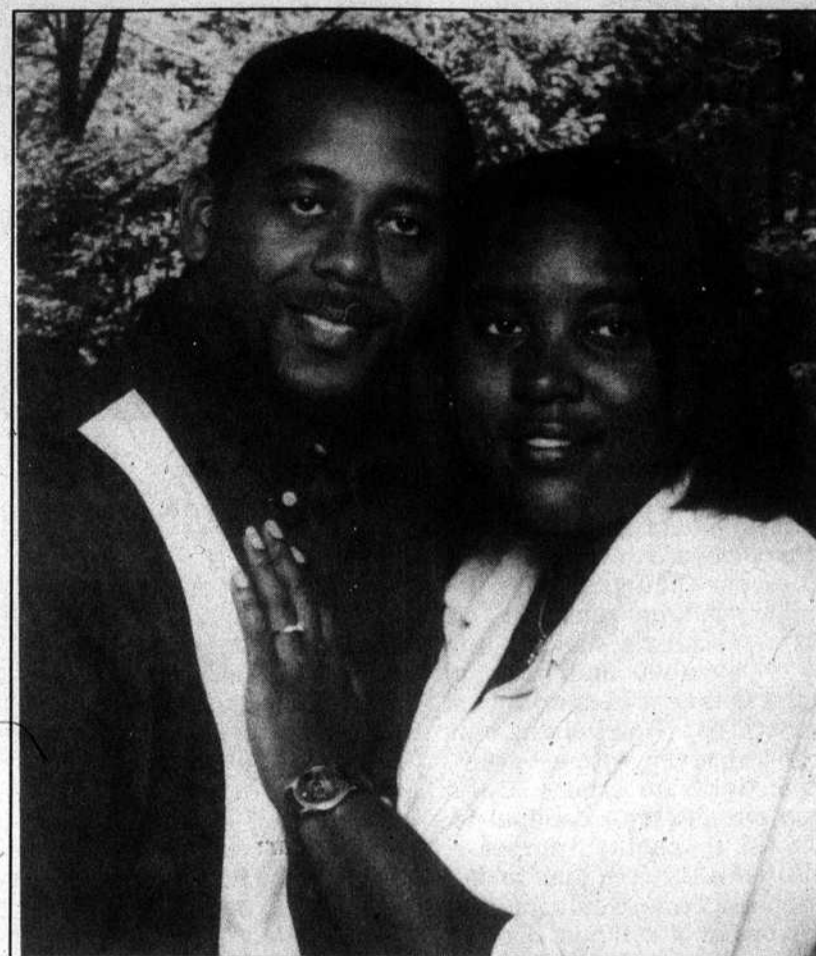

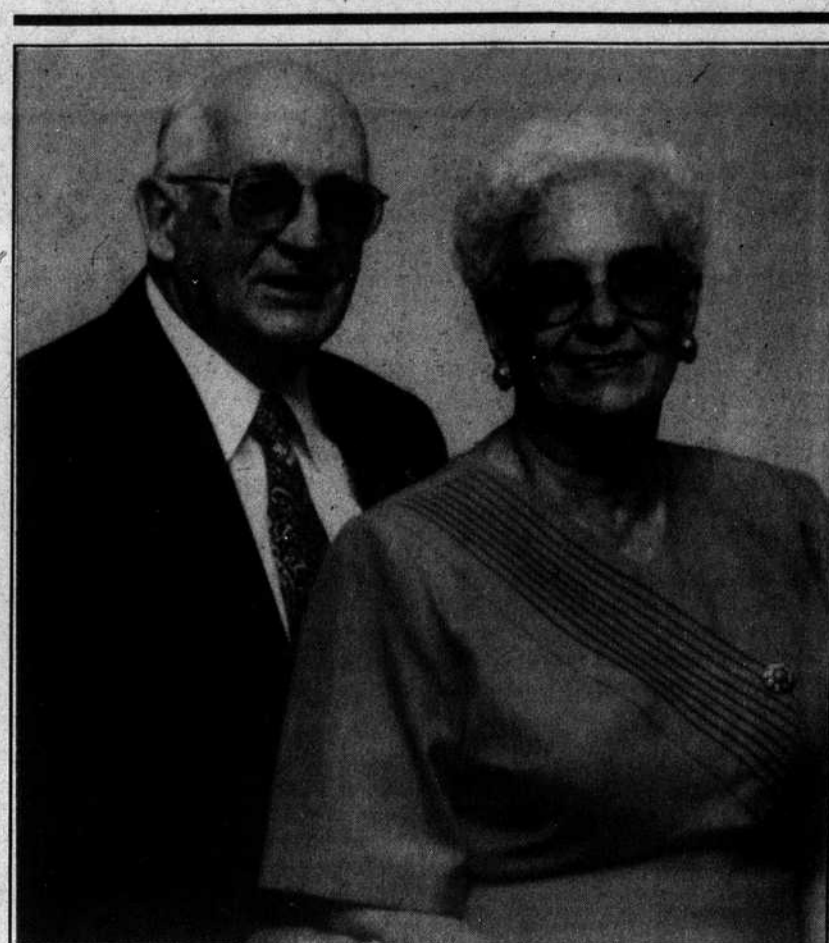

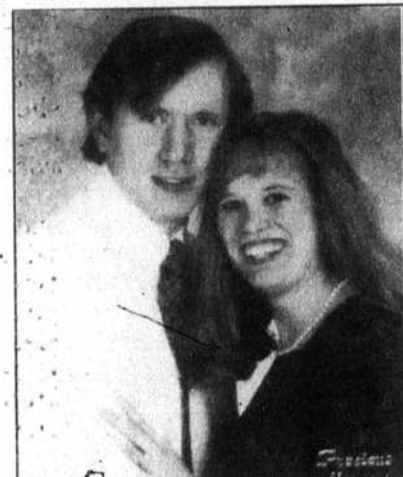
Ellis to be among debs
