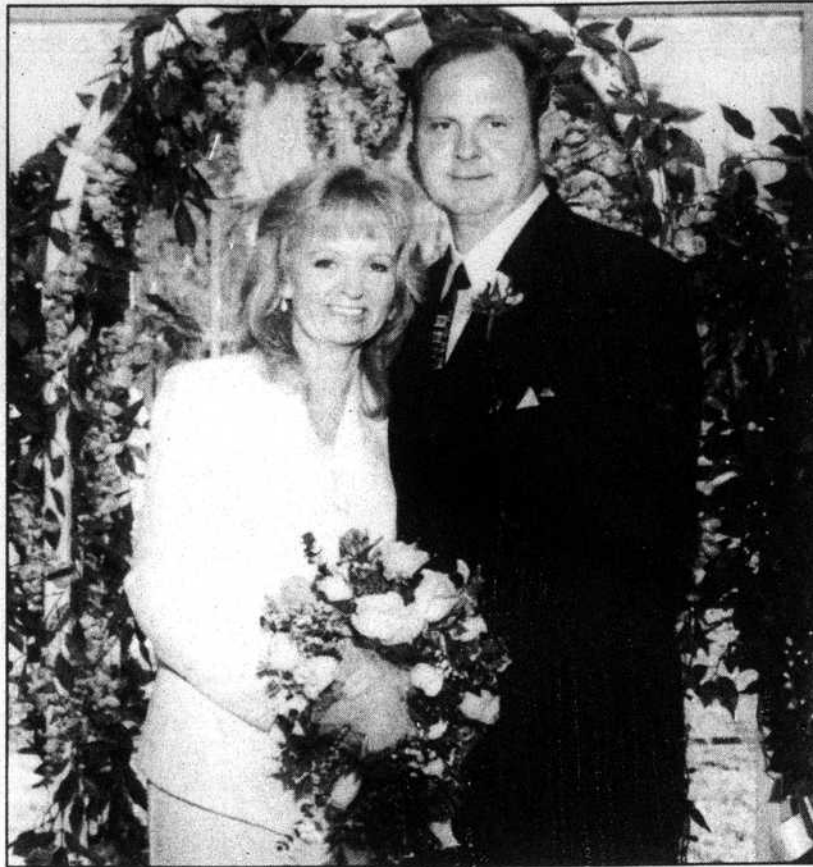




### WEDDING VOWS ARE EXCHANGED
