The little boy weighed 8 lbs., 6 ozs. and was 19 inches long.

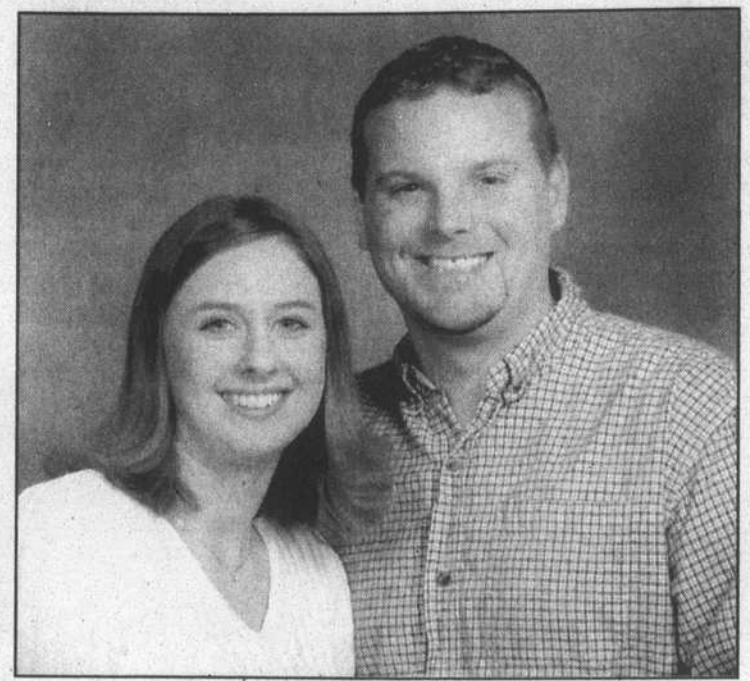

Partin is university honor graduate

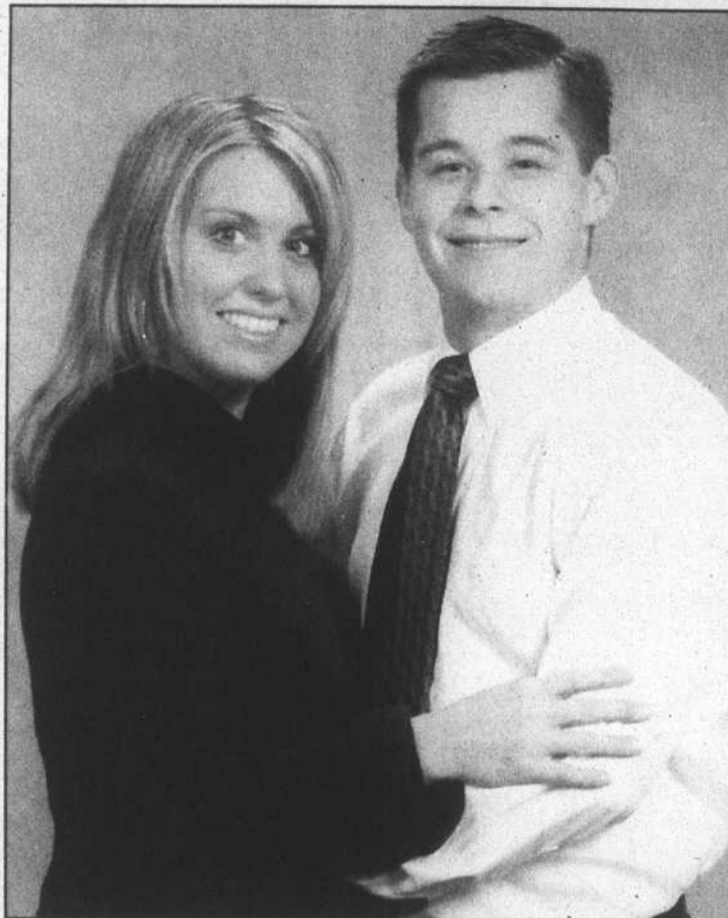
Kristy L. Partin graduated Dec. 13 summa cum laude from
