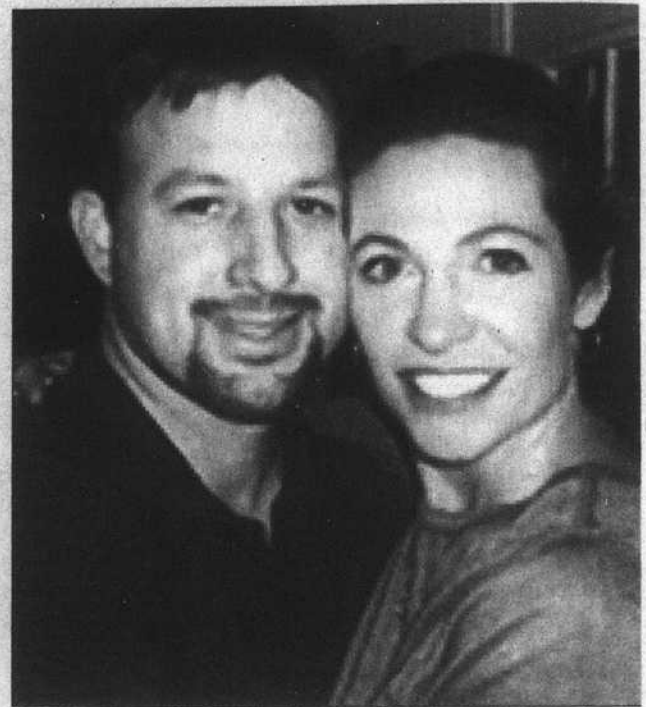

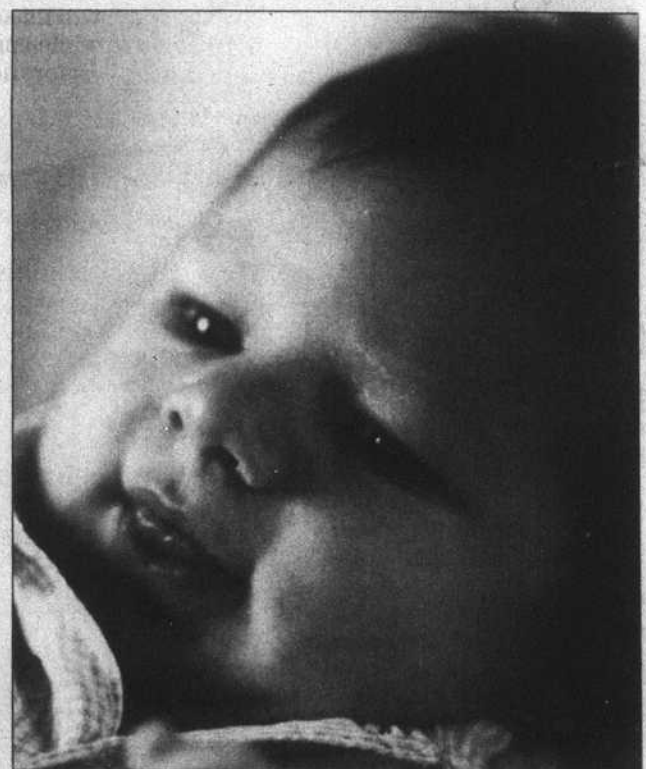

"We still think this is a good idea," Toppin said. "So we're going to try again."

Among those planning to take advantage of the special tickets will be Kermit Layton and his wife.

"I think that it (reduced

price ticket) makes a lot of sense for people that just want to go and look around, enjoy some carny food, and have some fun, but won't be riding anything," Layton said. "I'm glad to hear they're doing that."

Another special ticket will also be available this year on Wednesday, Sept. 25 that will be Military Appreciation Night. These \$10 tickets must also be purchased at the gate. Chilcoat said that these
