

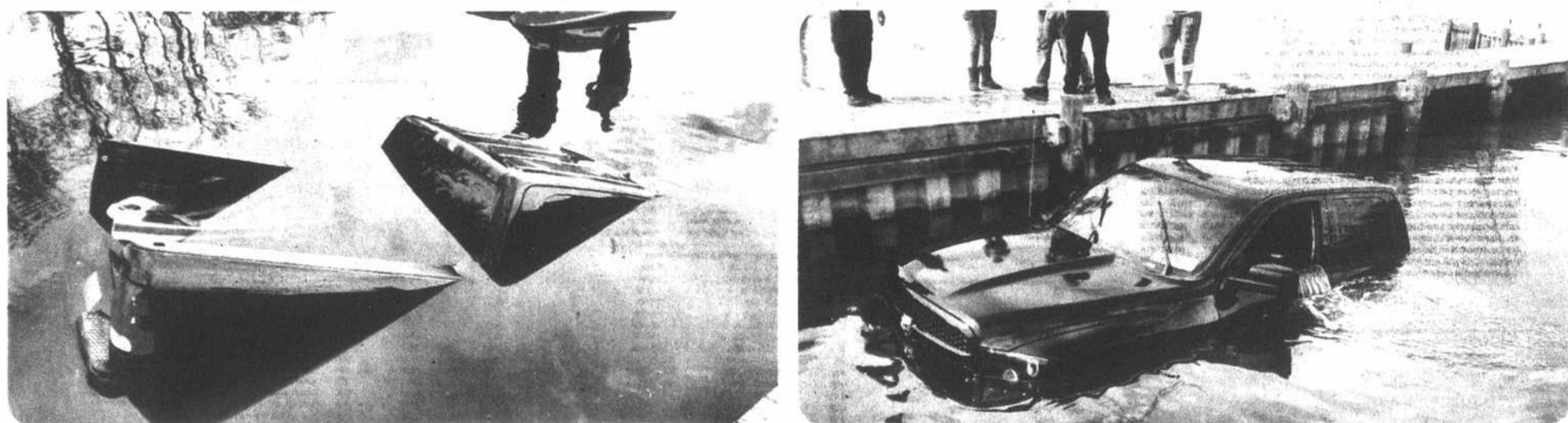
Dive team retrieves truck from water
