## Chowan County Tax Listing Notice 2017

### Real Property

All real property will be automatically listed to the January 1, 2017 owner. You will only receive a listing abstract for real property if the real property was newly acquired during 2016, if you receive a property tax exclusion or exemption on the property, or if there was a change in value. New construction must be reported to the tax department during the month of January.

### Personal Property

All personal property owned on January 1, 2017, except licensed motor vehicles, must be listed during the month of January. If you do not receive a listing form for personal property, contact the tax department.

List all unlicensed motor vehicles, permanent tagged vehicles, international registration plated vehicles, boats, boat motors, jet skis, all terrain vehicles, airplanes, farm equipment, and single-wide mobile homes.

All personal property must be listed by January 31, 2017 to avoid a 10% late listing penalty.

### Business Property

All businesses are required to file a business personal property form by January 31, 2017. Any business filing for the first time must contact the tax department to receive a listing form.

### Elderly / Permanently Disabled Exemption, Disabled Veterans Exemption, Circuit Breaker Exemption

If you are interested in applying for an exemption, you may request an application by calling 252-482-8487, and an application will be mailed. Applications are also available in the tax listing department of the Chowan County Tax Office, and on the county web site [www.chowancounty-nc.gov](http://www.chowancounty-nc.gov). All exemption applications must be filed no later than June 1, 2017.
